Being in constant high demand as a chamber musician, he has been a regular guest artist with numerous New York-based chamber music groups such as the Wind Soloists of New York, International Contemporary Ensemble, Sylvan Winds, Quintet of the Americas and Azure Ensemble as well as the Lyric Chamber Music Society, Wall Street Chamber Players, Sherman Ensemble and So Percussion.

As a klezmer music performer, Mr. Vinnitsky has appeared at some of the world's major music festivals and venues including Vienna Jewish Music Festival, Furth International Klezmer Festival (Germany), Ra'anana and Zfat Klezmer festivals in Israel and was featured as a klezmer clarinet and bass clarinet soloist with the Bachanalia String Orchestra at Merkin Concert Hall in New York City.

His recording credits include recent releases on New World and Bridge Records labels, numerous broadcasts on Israeli National TV and Bavarian Radio as well as an appearance on the Late Show with David Letterman on CBS. Mr. Vinnitsky holds degrees in clarinet performance from Tel-Aviv University and Yale University School of Music. His principal clarinet teachers were Richard Lesser, Steve Hartman and David Shifrin.
